Things to Know for First Grade

Student should be able to...

1. Print upper and lower case letters
2. Write first name and last name
3. Identify the letters of the alphabet
4. Identify the sounds of the letters
5. Blend simple 3 letter words (CVC)
6. Read simple sight words (attached)
7. Practice rhyming
8. Count the syllables in a word
9. Count to 100
10. Count by 10's, 5's, evens to 20, odds to 21
11. Add numbers to 10
12. Subtraction from 10
